

- Korthals Griffon Club of Great Britain (proposed) -

Club Representation.

Members & individuals may only represent this club - implicitly or implied in public or in the media by agreeing to the following code of conduct & ethic and by allowing the club full disclosure and by prior approval. Any and all documents, hand-outs, images and media, in any form digital or otherwise must also be first approved. If a fully paid up member of this club volunteers to represent the club at a show or exhibition, they must do so by adhering to the layout, guidelines and using display and public handout materials supplied in the 'exhibition Transport Pack'.

The following basic common guide must be adhered wherever possible and in so doing, having a responsibility to animal and this breed club:

1. The images and layout of and at any show, fair or exhibition must use all or most of the items from the 'Exhibition Transport Pack'. Any additional images or items must be approved prior to use.
2. The representative must be courteous and offer the views of the club and 'not' their own views or prejudices. You may, if asked, offer 'your own' experiences with 'your own' dog, making this clear to those concerned.
3. The representative or anyone accompanying shall 'not' use the opportunities presented to 'self promote' themselves, their animals, business or related services to the public in any way or form.
4. Abide by the clubs 'Code of Ethics' and in particular; item 14.
5. Any member of the public finding a good interest in the Korthals Griffon and/or the club must be asked for their contact details in exchange for further information being sent to them; stressing that all details are kept private.
6. The area of exhibition/club allocated space must be kept clean and tidy and free of debris at all times.
7. Club mechanics, methods of operation, and member matters with the club must 'not' be discussed with the public.
8. The consumption of food, alcohol, beverages and smoking is 'not' permitted within or near to the area of exhibition.
9. If you are to be accompanied by one or more 'Korthals Griffon(s)' They must conform to the KC breed standard, They must be in good health, They must be of good nature, They must not be pregnant and they must be fed and allowed access to water and exercise whenever needed.
10. Personal awards, cups, badges and certificates relating to the Korthals Griffon breed and/or the club may be displayed. Similar items for other breeds, events or services will not be allowed.
11. Loss, damage, theft or injuring to whomever or whatever while you represent the club is of limited liability, individual representatives may wish to take out their own additional insurances if necessary. The Korthals Griffon club may not/will not be liable in some cases.
